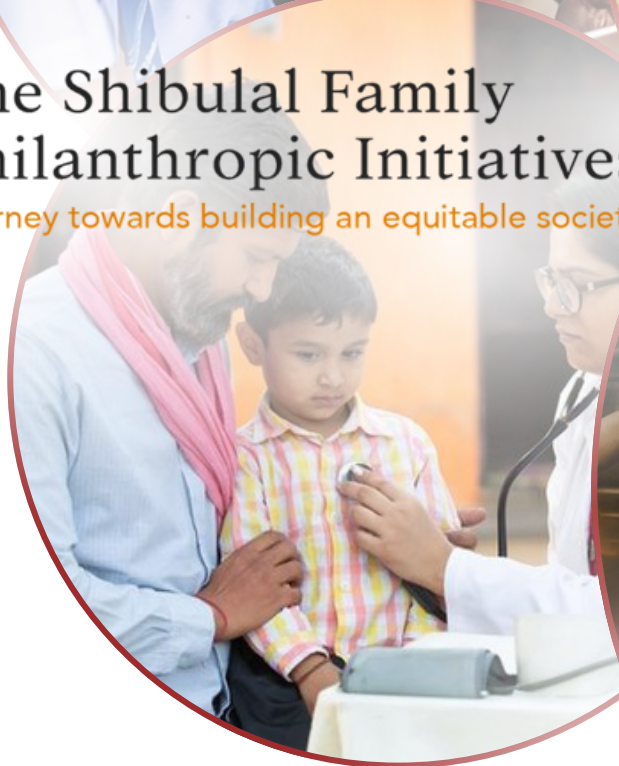

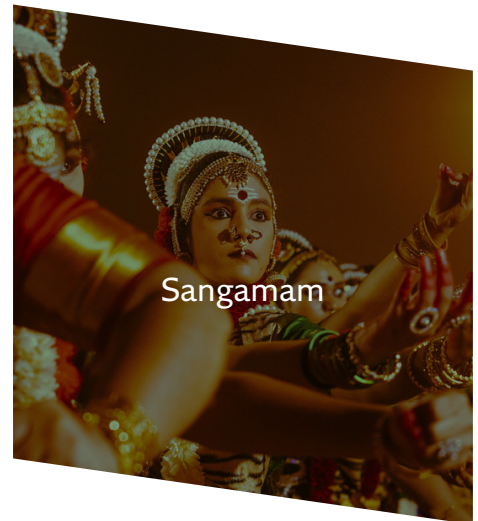

Organic Farming

Launched in 2009, Akshayasree promotes organic farming and honors farmers adopting best practices. Awards include State, District, and 28 consolation prizes across 14 districts. It also recognizes efforts in terrace farming, kitchen gardens, women farmers, students, and veteran farmers.

Healthcare

Started in 2000, AyuRaksha provides medical aid to children under 14 with life-threatening conditions.

- Across education, livelihood, culture & Leadership
- Education is the main area of focus.
- Vidyadhan graduates earn 3x their scholarship amount in the first year salary.
- 60% of Vidyadhan beneficiaries are girls; 90% from rural areas.
- 100% of families of Vidyadhan scholars move above the poverty line within 1-2 years of graduation.
- Vidyadhan alumni are employed in top companies like Infosys, TCS, Wipro, Accenture, ICICI.
- Target: 1 Lakh Vidyadhan scholarships across all Indian states by 2029.
- Shikshalokam- 4.5 L+ education leaders impacted, 150+ partners and 11.9 L micro improvements in public education system across 27 states.
- SAATHIYA has enrolled over 600 students into their system, with a placement rate of 98%.
- Navahitam 12,000 kgs of fruits and vegetables each month, benefiting a 1,000 individuals in 13 institutions.
- Organic farming awards helped farmers in enhancing confidence, gaining societal recognition and respect.
- AyurRaksha has supported 10,000+ patients across 12 hospitals.
